We are currently seeking **Residential Care Workers** for our Group Home in **Maple Ridge** and **Support Workers** for our Supported Independent Living Program based out of **Abbotsford** to provide support, care and Christian ministry to individuals with intellectual disabilities. Applicant must be 19 years of age or older.

Responsibilities will include providing personal care, helping to support positive social interactions, implementing programs and life skills training, exploring vocational and volunteer opportunities as well as providing social, recreational and leisure activities within the community.

Standard requirements for Support Workers of Bethesda include:

- Criminal Record Check through the Ministry of Justice
- Doctor's written verification of good health
- TB test results
- Immunization history information
- Current Driving Record Abstract
- Class 4 Driver's License (*Applicants must have class 5 drivers license to be considered for an interview*)
- First Aid and CPR certification approved for Residential Care

Applicants with a sincere desire to support people with disabilities are welcome to apply. Applicant must display strong ability in dealing with challenging behaviours. Training or previous experience in providing support to people with disabilities and autism is an asset. Additional training will be provided.
