



Participate in training as required.

Ensure children and youth take part in making decisions affecting their experiences in the program and can choose from available options.

Assist children in making a successful transition to new circumstances as identified by the ministry.

Maintain accurate records of children's relevant history and progress and maintaining the security and confidentiality of the records.

Promotes positive relationships with other household and community members including support staff, neighbours and friends.

### **Education and Experience:**

Diploma in related education and/or experience working with children and youth have experienced trauma and/or addictions and who require intensive ongoing emotional and behavioural supports. Experience working with children with disabilities is an asset.
