- support in his learning and utilizing appropriate social skills
- ensuring he has opportunity for social, recreational and leisure activities

Standard requirements for Support Workers of Bethesda include:

- Criminal Record Check through the Ministry of Public Safety and Solicitor General
- Doctor’s written verification of good health
- TB test results
- Immunization history information
- Current Driving Record Abstract
- First Aid and CPR certification approved for Residential Care

Applicants with a sincere desire to support someone with a disability are welcome to apply. Training will be provided. Long term employment with part time/casual hours is available.
