



Residential Care Workers – Richmond & Ladner

Bethesda Christian Association's mission is to support people with disabilities and their families with the attitude and motivation like that of the Good Samaritan. Primarily, Bethesda supports individuals who have intellectual disabilities. Bethesda's ministry is a Christian faith-based service.

Bethesda is currently seeking ***Residential Care Workers*** for their Group Homes in ***Richmond and Ladner***. Permanent and casual positions are available. Applicant must be 19 years of age or older.

Responsibilities will include providing personal care, helping to support positive social interactions, implementing programs and life skills training, exploring vocational and volunteer opportunities as well as providing social, recreational and leisure activities within the community.

Standard requirements for Residential Care Workers of Bethesda include:

- Criminal Record Check through the Ministry of Justice
- Doctor's written verification of good health
- TB test results
- Immunization history information
- Current Driving Record Abstract
- Class 4 Driver's License (*Applicants must have class 5 drivers license to be considered for an interview*)
- First Aid and CPR certification approved for Residential Care

Applicants with a sincere desire to support people with disabilities are welcome to apply. Strong ability in providing support for challenging behaviours is required. Autism Training and/or previous experience in providing support to people with disabilities is an asset. Additional training will be provided.
