

What to expect When you vote

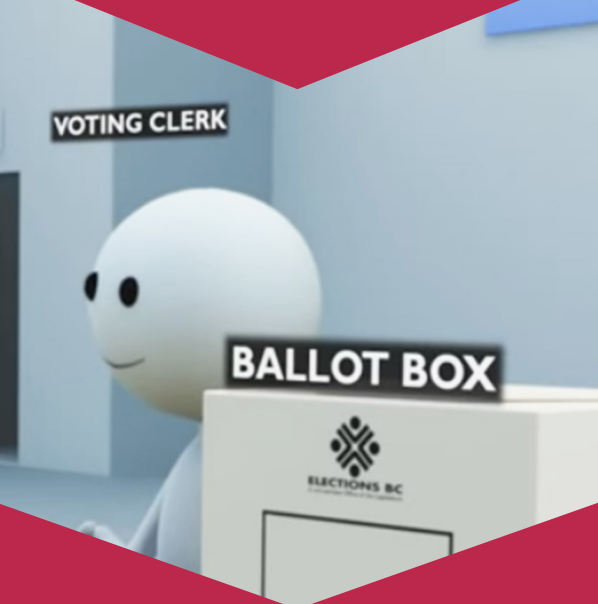


1 At the voting place an election worker will greet you and show you to the right table.



Bring your **ID** and **Where to Vote card** to the voting place. If you didn't get a **Where to Vote card** you can still vote.

2 At the table show the election workers your ID.



Then you will sign the voting book to show that you haven't already voted, and that you are a Canadian citizen, 18 or older, and a resident of B.C. for the past six months.

3 The election worker will call out your name and voter number.



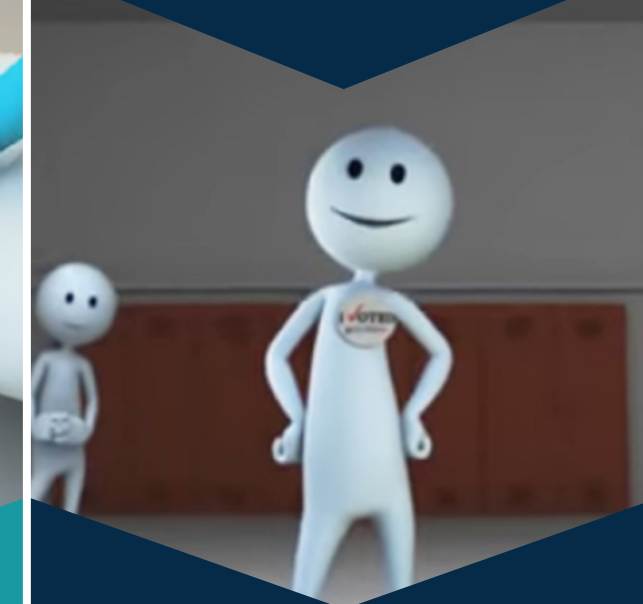
They will initial, fold, and hand you your ballot.

4 Take the ballot behind the voting screen, unfold it, and mark it with an **x** or **✓**.



Refold the ballot and return it to the election worker. They will make sure the ballot is the same one they gave you. Then you or the election worker will put it in the ballot box.

5 There! You voted.



And on the way out the door you'll get an **'I Voted' sticker** to prove it.
