This is a fantastic Home Share opportunity in the Aldergrove/West Abbotsford area for a single person or family that understands the call to serve others.

A middle-aged male with autism is looking for a home. He is independent, friendly, polite and has a part-time job. He loves attending church as faith is very important to him. He also loves going out for coffee and being on his computer.

This gentleman is looking for a loving Christian home to offer social interaction and relationship. He has low support needs, but could use help in developing skills in areas such as cooking or laundry.

You may be a good match for this gentleman. Ideally, your home has a separate living area, with a suite or suite-like set up, and is close to the bus route. A home with children and pets is ok.

As a Home Share Provider, you are not alone. You are supported by a Home Share team at Bethesda who will walk alongside you through the interviews, explain how it works, set up a home share contract, and be there to advise, assist and share with you the joys and challenges!

Home Share is a contract arrangement where a family or single person provides support for a person with intellectual disabilities in their home. A suitable contract will be established. Bethesda will provide ongoing support to the individual/couple/family providing care. Bethesda exists to support people with diverse abilities and thrives in reciprocal relationships, inclusive communities, and lifestyles rooted in true belonging. Bethesda's ministry is a Christian faith-based service.
