Hours: Varies based on the needs of the family. Must be available a minimum of one weekend per month.

Wage: A per diem rate between \$100-200 per diem

Job Description:

Our Children's Respite Program supports families who have a child with a disability (this could include physical and/or developmental disabilities or complex medical needs, Respite is a family-to-family program where the child typically goes into the home of the caregiver to provide the family with a break. Respite visits generally happen over a weekend on an overnight basis. However, a more flexible schedule can be designed to meet the needs of the family and caregiver availability.

What you bring to the job:

The ideal candidate will have a stable and caring home environment where they can provide support for a child. They will have experience or an interest in supporting children who have developmental disabilities and may have education as a Community Support Worker, EA, or Social Worker.

Requirements:

- Current First Aid or willingness to obtain
- Pass a criminal record check during screening
- Past experience providing respite care an asset
- Ability to assist with personal care
